Terms and conditions for guest projects at Peripherie 8 – this is not an open call!

From now on, guest projects can once again be submitted to us alongside the internal Peripherie 8 programme :-)

However, we have adjusted our terms and conditions, as we do not receive any funding for the space; this is because the cultural policy landscape for open spaces in the original sense has taken an unfavourable turn. We are, however, committed to continuing to find ways to ensure fair working conditions for cultural practitioners. Upon receipt of your application, the Peripherie 8 team is expected to discuss the proposal at its board meeting in January 2027 and inform you of the decision as soon as possible. We will therefore be accepting project proposals on an ongoing basis from autumn 2027, depending on the number of applications, until 2028.

Here are our new conditions:

▲ **In terms of content**, the project must fit the profile of Peripherie 8. In keeping with the motto of PERIPHERIE 8: Experimental, Poetic and Performative, we aim to provide a space for independently curated projects within a professional framework.

▲ **Formally**, various options are possible: from one day to a maximum of one month; from visual arts and performance to dance, literature and poetry, video and audio art, experimental music, and interdisciplinary projects.

▲ Peripherie 8 provides its **infrastructure** (space, tools, technology, e.g., 2 projectors) and However, in return, we expect careful handling and compensation for any damage. The space and infrastructure must be returned in perfect condition after dismantling.

▲ **The contact person** is usually Thea or someone else from the collective. We will supervise your project and hand over the space to you and then take it back again.

▲ **Public relations**: We will make an entry on our website and post about the collaboration on our Instagram channel. For analog flyers, posters, and graphics, a care package can be booked in addition upon request; otherwise, the project organizers are responsible for these themselves.

▲ **Budget**: Each project is responsible for its own budget. However, we will help with any uncertainties and support the project with budgeting and, if necessary, we will be available to provide advice.

▲ We are now dependent on **rental income**, so the corresponding room rental must always be included in the budget. Unless you are a volunteer collective member of Peripherie 8, in which case this does not apply.

▲ **Supervision**: the project is responsible for looking after the exhibition and is responsible for maintaining the technology itself.

▲ **Beverages & bar operation**: the project is responsible for its own beverages at its own expense and may use our bar furniture with appropriate refrigerators for this purpose. Cans, plastic bottles, and glass bottles must be disposed of by the project itself.

- **CV** and **portfolio**
- A rough **budget** with a financing plan
- **Your preferred dates and possible alternative months/dates in Autumn 2027 & Year 2028**
